True Northwoods Dog Mushing Experience

We're located 7 miles up the Arrowhead Trail in Hovland, north of Grand Marais, MN, USA. You'll park in a nearby parking area then your adventure begins! Our remote cabin is located close to a mile from the plowed road. Bring your own Snowshoes or Cross Country Skis or they can be rented from Stone Harbor Wilderness Supply. The trek into our cabin is a grounding experience with breathtaking views that set the stage for an unforgettable dog sledding experience. If a snowshoe or ski of this distance is not for you, we're happy to make other arrangements to get you back into the cabin for an additional fee.



You'll be immersed in the lifestyle of a northwoods dog musher once you make your way to our little remote log cabin tucked away in the woods. This promises to be an experience of a lifetime!

The Points Unknown sled dogs are friendly and exuberant and always up for adventure. You'll not only be taken by dog team for an adventure on our deep woods bush trails but you'll learn how to properly interact with the sled dogs, harness them and hook them up to the sled. For those dog lovers, there will be plenty of cuddle time with the sled dogs!



The timeline for your entire adventure is flexible and between 2 and 3 hours in length. We have two time slots available: 9-12Noon and 1:00-4:00 each day. If you've chosen the morning adventure, please arrive in the parking area by 9AM to take full advantage of your time with us. If you're a late riser, not a problem! Just know that we need to let our dogs rest and fuel ourselves at 12Noon in preparation for our afternoon adventure.

Prior to your adventure, we'll chat with you about what you can expect, how to dress and if you have any special needs of which we need to be aware, all done so that your time with us can be most fulfilling.

For optimal trail time, we suggest no more than 4 people in each time slot, however, we can tailor the adventure to your group so let's chat! For the safety and enjoyment of the dogs, musher and you, there is a weight limit in place of 275# per sled with no more than two people per sled. (1 adult/1 child, 2 smaller adults or 1 person in each sled)

Children under the age of 5 are invited to come along to meet the dogs, however, we've found, over the years, that their experience in the sled can be a very unpleasant one and there is nowhere to turn around once we've left the dog yard.
